FFFF Close-up Convention by Henry Holava

Joe Cabral and I recently attended the prestige's "Fechter's Finger Flicking Frolic" close-up convention commonly referred to as the 4F convention; held annually in Batavia New York. A record 234 invited magicians were in attendance.

Over the course of four days, we got to attend six lectures, a workshop on promotional gifts, Teach-a-Trick session and six close-up shows, and still found time to spend some of my money in the dealer's room. Lectures were given by Richard Pinner from the UK, Alex Hecklua from Germany, Jon Allan from the UK, Steve Beam from the USA, Marcelo Insua from Argentina and Astor from Hungary. A total of seventy magicians from around the world (USA, Canada, Spain, Italy, Sweden, Hungary, France, Argentina, Holland, Germany, Scotland and England) performed in the six close-up shows. There were several standing ovations but I thought Paul Gertner's high tech routine with an iPad was outstanding magic.

Steve Bargatze and Rick Merrill closed the Saturday evening show with an outrage comedy bit in which Bargatzi had to reveal a chosen card. Merrill put donuts on Bargatzi's eyes; wrapped his head with duct tape, and put a bag over his head to make sure he couldn't see the chosen card. Then all hell broke loose when Merrill started hitting Bargatzi over the head with an Aluminum baking pan because he thought Bargatzi was lying that he couldn't see. Soon, people from the audience (Oscar Munoz, Bob Sheets, Steve Bean, Paul Gertner, Shawn Farquhar, and Eric Joans) joined in beating Bargatzi over the head. It got so violent that Howe Schwartzman got up and left the room. As bargatzi was dragged off the stage, he produced the chosen card.
