### **David Copperfield Named Magician of the Century**

New York, NY (September 14, 2011) The Society of American Magicians awarded illusionist David Copperfield their highest honor, "Magician of the Century", and named him the `King of Magic,' an award which has never before been given by the S.A.M. is recognizing Copperfield for his efforts to preserve, promote and enhance the art of magic throughout his legendary career. National president, Vinny Grosso, said that Copperfield has, "accomplished more than anyone else in the field of magic today."

Among his many achievements, S.A.M. highlighted Copperfield's dedication to excellence which has earned him the Living Legend Award from The Library of Congress, the first Star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame awarded to a living magician, a knighthood by the French government, 11 Guinness World Records and 21 Emmy awards. He has sold more tickets than any other solo artist in history and recently crossed \$3 billion in ticket sales worldwide. In 1982, Copperfield created Project Magic, which teaches sleight-of-hand magic to those with disabilities as a method of physical and occupational therapy.

In addition, Copperfield is the creator and curator of the International Museum and Library of Conjuring Arts, which holds the world's largest collection of historical magical artifacts, including Houdini's Water Torture Cell and Orson Welles' Buzz Saw Illusion.

Copperfield said, "I'm humbled by the honor and grateful to be recognized by this great organization."

**Exploring the World of Magician Albert Walker (1836-1902)**

Magician and historian Robert Olson, known to many for his work at Old Sturbridge Village and his performances as 19th century magician Richard Potter, will appear in Hartford on Saturday afternoon October 22, 2011. Mr. Olson will present a two-part program to highlight the Connecticut Historical Society's Albert Walker collection. Some items from this collection are featured in the recently-opened Making Connecticut exhibit.

2:00 PM ~ Who Was Albert Walker? – Robert Olson will talk about the life and work of Albert Walker, born in Glastonbury, Connecticut in 1836, and the value and importance of the extensive and unusual collection (paper ephemera, diaries, personal papers, and magician's props) that was acquired by the CHS in 2007.

3:00 PM ~ An Afternoon of Victorian Magic – Mr. Olson will appear "in character" as a mid-19th-century Connecticut magician, performing many of the tricks and illusions of Albert Walker's time. Cards fly about, coins jump into a spectator's hand, metal rings link and unlink; a piece of folded paper becomes dozens of different items. The program is suitable for adults, families and school age children, six and up. The magic takes place close-up and in their hands.
